

Memorandum of Understanding

Loving Our Communities to Christ (Mission America Coalition)
and Community Transformation Inc. (of Thomasville, GA)

Mission America Coalition (MAC/LC2C) promises to:

1. Provide a Coach at no cost to your city for 3 years who communicates on a regular basis with your city reacher, your leadership team and your pastors.
2. Provide additional MAC/LC2C personnel to consult or train in the areas of prayer, evangelism, compassion, fund raising, partnership development, etc.
3. Mobilize prayer support for your city through our LC2C cities and the Mission America Coalition partners and networks.
4. Inform LC2C Lead Teams of potential partnerships with member ministries of the Mission America Coalition.
5. Provide “learning community” opportunities for all LC2C participating cities for equipping and encouraging.
6. Be accountable to these agreements for as long as each party finds them to be mutually beneficial and led by the Lord.

Community Transformation Inc. (CTI) promises to:

1. Seek a diverse, critical mass of Christian clergy, congregational, marketplace and ministry leaders to serve as the Lead Team with each person committing to model and to lead other individuals and congregations into a Prayer-Care-Share lifestyle.
2. Prayerfully, with the assistance and guidance of our coach, seek to discern God’s vision, set strategies, and implement goals and action steps that enable the Church in our city to pursue a Prayer-Care-Share culture across all levels and sectors of the Church.
3. Seek to mobilize, encourage and train prayer support for our vision and strategy in participating congregations and through marketplace prayer networks with a goal toward encouraging city-wide prayer networks to emerge as God leads.
4. Seek to recruit and send a diverse representation to LC2C Learning Community gatherings, as God provides and leads, in order to share our City’s initiatives with others and to receive mutual encouragement, prayer and ideas from other participating communities.
5. As requested, provide reports and share research, stories and statistics describing and detailing our LC2C progress so that it can be shared with others for encouragement and example.
6. As God provides, Prayerfully consider giving into the LC2C Movement to enable other cities to experience the same coaching benefit that we have received.
7. Be accountable to these agreements for as long as each party finds them to be mutually beneficial and led by the Lord.
